Minutes of the SLBC Sub Committee on Agriculture meeting dated 22/12/2020

Agenda: Fixation of Ceiling Price of Potato for 2020-21 Seasons.

The meeting was held on 22.12.2020 to finalize the ceiling price of potato for financing the cold storagesfor on-lending to the farmers as well as directly to the farmers. The meeting was graced by The Director, Institutional Finance (GoWB), Asstt General Managers from RBI & NABARD, Joint Secretary, Agri Marketing Department along with the representatives of the West Bengal Cold Storage Owners Association and the member banks.

At the outset, the House was informed about the process of arriving at the price of potato considering various parameters related to pre-harvest & post-harvest costs involved in cultivation and storage. SLBC informed that data on the same was collected from 9 predominantly potato growing districts, viz. Murshidabad, Purulia, Purba Burdwan, Paschim Burdwan, Birbhum, Hooghly, Paschim Medinipur, Bankura and Malda through the LDMs. The House was requested to take a consensus call on the same for arriving at a uniform price for the state under the prevailing market condition. It was stated by the cold storage owners that the stores were informed to offload the potato stored previous year by 30.11.2020 as loading of new potato for the current season is expected to commence from 1stweek of March, 2021. In the discussion all the Banks agreed not to take any margin amount on total storage capacity of the cold storages.

After a detailed discussion and based on the inputs from the participants regarding major expenses for preparation of land, fertilizers-pesticides, seeds, irrigation, labour cost etc. it was assessed that the average production cost would be around Rs. 68892/-for the current year. Increment in the cost of production this year is mainly due to increase in cost of seed potato. The yield per acre was assumed at around 128 quintals (including non-sorted potatoes).

Based on the discussions, the House agreed for the following item wise average cost of production:

The house was also appraised that as the above pricing exercise is based on certain assumptions, it may be subjected to revision according to the ground situation prevailing at the time of harvesting as well as storing which may have either positive or negative impact on the pricing parameters. This information regarding prevailing ground situation may be obtained from the concerned line Department of Govt of West Bengal. Accordingly, it was also agreed upon that in such a scenario,re-assessment of potato price, as fixed above, would be further examined and rationally revised by convening another meeting at a short notice to the members of the committee and representatives of Cold Storage Owners.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the chair & participants by Mr. N. Roy.
