iii. Animal Husbandry:

Madam Joyoshi Das Gupta, IAS, Senior Special Secretary to Govt. of West Bengal, ARD Department proposed a detailed SoF for working capital of ARD Schemes and also for KCC ARD, for the year 2023-24 and the same was unanimously accepted by the house.

iv. Fishery:

Dr. Kishore Dhara, Dy. Director of Fisheries submitted the SoF for Fishery projects under KCC and MJCC during 2023-24. Dr. Dhara pointed out that a number of schemes mentioned in their proposal are prepared keeping in line with Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampad Yojna, so that they can be implemented through the schemes. The fish vending on bicycle on insulated box could not be approved in terms of RBI Memo No. FIDD. KOL.LBS.No.488/ 03.01.025/ 2020-21 dated June 29, 2020. However Dr. Dhara mentioned that such fish vending machines are provided under Banga Matsya Yojana.

The proposed SoF for Fisheries was approved by the House. The aforementioned SoF for Fisheries Schemes has been annexed in **Annexure-4**
